A true choral enthusiast, Alastair has held counter tenor positions at Portsmouth Cathedral, St. Mary's Episcopal Cathedral, Edinburgh, and Canterbury Cathedral.

He also sang regularly for many years with the choirs of Westminster Abbey and St. Paul's Cathedral, London.

His solo commitments include The Chichester Psalms by Leonard Bernstein as part of the Malta International Arts Festival.

Having studied Early Music Performance at Trinity Laban Conservatoire, London, Alastair now runs the Choir Church Project for the Diocese of Portsmouth, creating and training new infant choirs in the parish of Milton.
