Music:

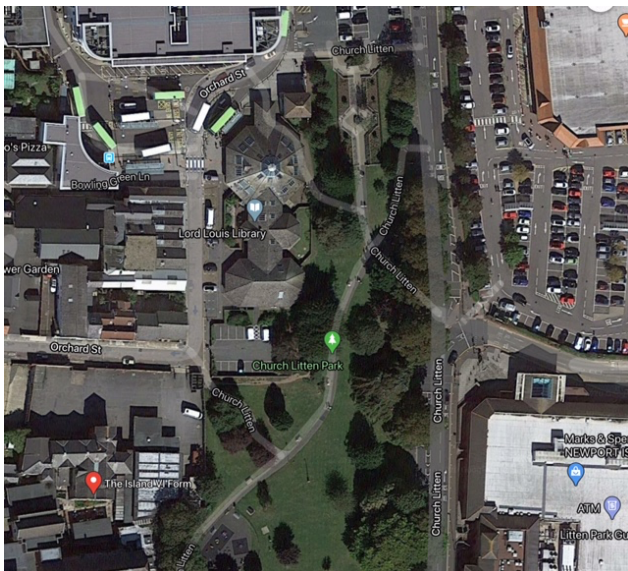
- Music will be provided by separate arrangement upon receipt of your booking.

Venue:

- The Island VI Form College is located next to Church Litten Park and behind Newport's Lord Louis Library (see red pin marker in bottom left-hand corner of the map below).
- Entrance to the Main Assembly Hall of The Island VI Form College is at the rear of the building, via Orchard Street (this street runs between Newport Bus Station and Lord Louis Library).

Arrival:

- There is free on-site parking, accessible via the Orchard Street entrance (see photo below). We encourage the principle of car-sharing.
- There are additional car parks within a few minutes' walk of the venue, all are chargeable:
 - Church Litten car park (short stay duration only)
 - Marks & Spencer (first 2 hours free)
 - Multi-storey car park above Mountain Warehouse (previously Co-op)
- Bus Stops: Newport Bus Station is a few minutes' walk along Orchard Street.



Accessibility:

Although the Main Assembly Hall entrance has a low threshold, the toilets are up a short flight of stairs and, unfortunately, are not wide-enough for wheelchair access.
